Hereby apply to the Skaha Estates Improvement District for a supply of water through a connection to the works of the District.

The type of residence or building to be served is: _____

All new water service and major renovation as determined by the trustees of the improvement district, especially renovations involving the excavation of a water line or curb stop, must install a meter pit with a backflow prevention valve and secondary water shutoff valve. The applicant can purchase the meter pit from the improvement district or from another supplier providing the device meets the standard design of the improvement district. The meter pit must be installed close to the curb stop on the applicant's water line. The installation of the meter pit must be one so the lid of the pit is easily accessible and must be witnessed and confirmed by an improvement district Trustee or authorized representative prior to backfill of soil. The purchase of the meter at this time is optional but may become mandatory in the future at the applicant's expense. All costs borne by the purchase and installation of the meter pit is the responsibility of the applicant.

All irrigation waterlines to have a separate turn off located on private property.

In the event of this application being granted, I/We covenant and agree to be bound by the regulations, charges, terms and conditions set out and imposed by the Bylaws of the improvement district and all amendments thereto, and further agree that the said Skaha Estates Improvement District shall in no case be liable for shortage or failure of water supply.

It is declared that this Agreement shall be binding upon my heirs, executors and administrators and that all charges payable in respect to the above premises under the District Bylaws shall constitute a charge against the said land, pursuant to the provisions in the "Local Government Act".
